Mid-year budget review postponed amid IMF talks – Bloomberg: Finance Minister Ken Ofori-Atta will not present the Mid-Year Review of the Budget Statement and Economic Policy of the government and Supplementary Estimates for the 2022 Financial Year to Parliament on Wednesday, July 13, 2022, Bloomberg has reported. According to the international news agency, the presentation has been put on hold as the government engages the International Monetary Fund for a programme. 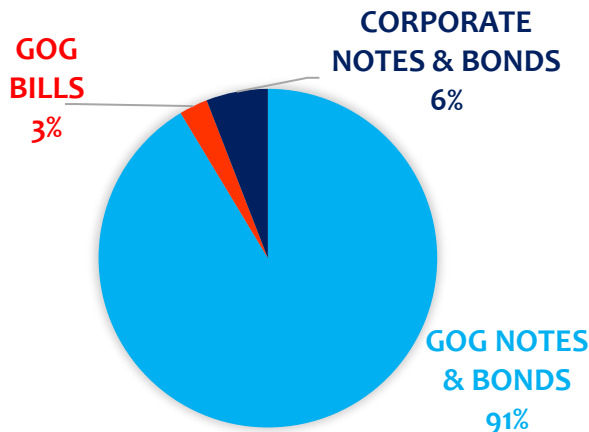

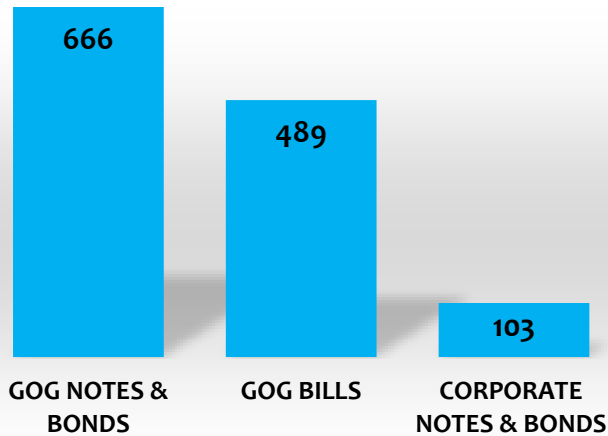

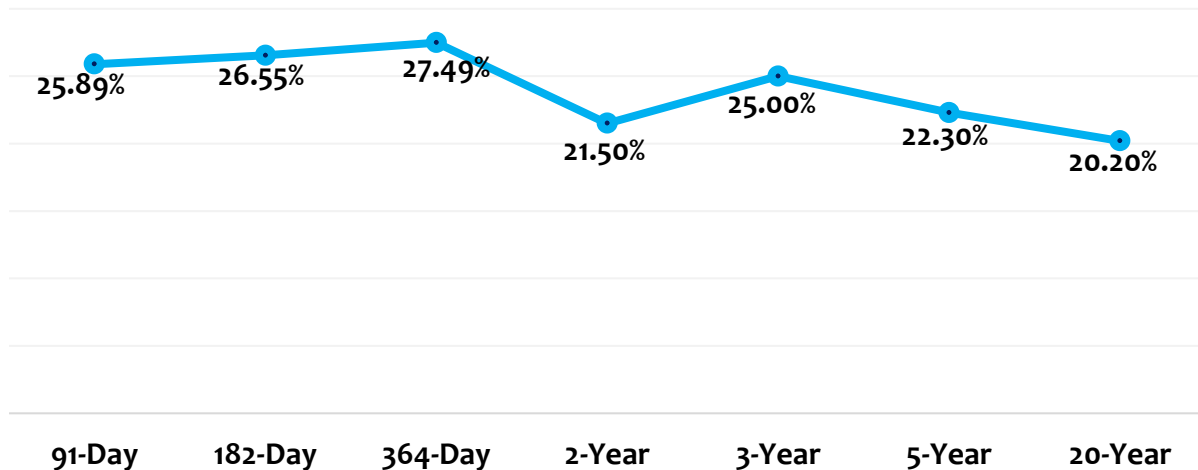
