


- Mid-year budget review postponed amid IMF talks Bloomberg: Finance Minister Ken Ofori-Atta will not present the Mid-Year Review of the Budget Statement and Economic Policy of the government and Supplementary Estimates for the 2022 Financial Year to Parliament on Wednesday, July 13, 2022, Bloomberg has reported. According to the international news agency, the presentation has been put on hold as the government engages the International Monetary Fund for a programme. However, it will most likely be rescheduled for later this month. (Ghanaweb)
- IMF team to engage Bawumia, Parliament today: The visiting team from the International Monetary Fund (IMF) is expected to engage the Vice President, Dr Mahamudu Bawumia, today as part of its data gathering and engagement with the government. 


