- Ghana and China to Finalise Zero-Tariff Trade Agreement by End-October: Ghana and China are set to finalise a zero-tariff trade agreement by October 2025, aiming to boost Ghana's export competitiveness and industrial growth. President John Dramani Mahama praised China's decision as an act of solidarity, stating that the agreement would create new markets for Ghanaian exporters, agro-processors, and manufacturers. The zero-tariff initiative is part of China's policy to extend duty-free treatment to all 53 African countries, aiming to deepen diplomatic and economic ties and secure fairer trade relations with global partners. 
