- Ghana to create independent Fiscal Council to guide policy and debt levels: The Ministry of Finance has announced plans to establish an independent Fiscal Council as part of sweeping reforms aimed at tightening oversight of Ghana's public finances and restoring fiscal discipline. Chief Director of the Ministry, Patrick Nomo disclosed the move and explained that the Fiscal Council, backed by recent amendments to the Public Financial Management (PFM) Act, will serve as a watchdog over fiscal policy making and Implementation. The Council is expected to enhance transparency, strengthen credibility in public financial management and help prevent a recurrence of past mismanagement that contributed to macroeconomic instability. - \* BoG Directs Mining Firms to Route Forex Inflows Through Commercial Banks: The Bank of Ghana (BoG) has instructed mining companies to channel their foreign exchange inflows through commercial banks, rather than directly to the central bank, as part of efforts to deepen interbank forex trading and boost market liquidity. Governor of the BoG, Dr. Johnson Asiama, disclosed the directive in a briefing with industry players this week, noting that the change was necessitated by current market conditions. He emphasised that the measures form part of the Bank's broader interventions to ease pressures on the cedi and strengthen forex availability within the formal market. (Norvanreports)
